

SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENT

A local charity is sponsoring a website contest to help raise money for their organization. Expanding on the sale of handmade items they buy from local artisans in El Salvador/Haiti/Italy/China and then sell in Arlington--which raises money to support education--they want to sell traditional and contemporary clothing from that country. To prepare your website, you need to first do some research into typical clothing, reading about both traditional and contemporary clothes. Then, interview some classmates to find out what they like to wear and what items you think will be the most popular for sale in Arlington. Finally, make your website in the target language, including images of clothing, descriptions, prices, and how the profits will be used to support the organization.
