- 5. What was the final decision made by the community board? [To deny the variance.]
- 6. What core democratic values were used in making the land use decision? [Rule of law, freedom of speech, freedom of assembly, and common good.]
- 7. What might the landowner do now? [Decide not to build, try to purchase additional land, or build a smaller complex that could meet the parking requirements.]
